2. Before the park visit, students should realize that they are coming to the park to learn, as well as have fun.
3. Discuss the proper behavior expected of each student. Explain that safety rules in the park are for each person's safety and these rules must be obeyed.
4. Review the assignments with your students just before the field trip. Help students understand what is required of them before the actual trip.
